Memorandum of Understanding

The University of Edinburgh College of Medicine and Veterinary Medicine and the Jagiellonian University Medical College wishing to extend and further develop their longstanding academic links and unique tradition of cooperation between their Institutions forged with the establishment of The Polish School of Medicine at The University of Edinburgh in 1941 and through the Polish School of Medicine Memorial Fund Scholarship programme, hereby declare their intention to co-operate in the fields of scientific research and academic activity with the intention of fostering and developing mutually beneficial relations between their institutions at postgraduate and at undergraduate level.

Both parties will seek to promote postgraduate and undergraduate student mobility by encouraging their students to participate in the existing Polish School of Medicine related scholarship programmes, academic courses, summer schools and other relevant activities and programmes according to the methods and provisions described in the accompanying working document.
