**Ordinance No 46  
of the Rector of the Jagiellonian  
University**

**on: functioning of the Jagiellonian University from 25th May 2020 until 30th September 2020 and repealing of the ordinance no 24 of the Rector of the Jagiellonian University of 10th March 2020 on preventing the spread of COVID-19 in the academic community of the Jagiellonian University and ordinance no 28 of the Rector of the Jagiellonian University of 13th March 2020 on special working arrangements at the Jagiellonian University**

On the basis of the Art. 23 section 1 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Dz. U. of 2020 item 85 as amended) and with reference to the regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 11th March 2020 on the temporary limitation of functioning of some entities of the higher education and science system regarding the prevention, counteracting and combating COVID-19 (Dz. U. of 2020 item 405 as amended) I hereby order as follows:

§ 1

1. All conferences, events organized by the university and faculties and sports events shall be cancelled excepted events organized on-line.
2. All business travels abroad and participation in domestic conferences of our employees, doctoral students and students of the JU shall be suspended and domestic business travels shall be limited to the strictly necessary.
3. Visits to the Jagiellonian University of foreign visitors shall be suspended.

§ 2

1. First-, second-, long-cycle, doctoral studies, postgraduate studies and courses shall be suspended. Classes are conducted remotely with the use of the remote education techniques subject to the section 4 and 6.
2. Research shall be conducted in safe conditions, taking into consideration the current threat to health of employees, students and doctoral students and law in force that regulates terms of performing work.
3. Regulations regarding fulfilling of organizational duties applicable before the introduction of special working arrangements at the Jagiellonian University shall be restored.
4. A dean/director/head of entity of extra- or inter-faculty at the JU after receiving a positive opinion from Faculty's Student Government Council/a president of the Student Government and, in case of doctoral students, PhD Association, can agree to organize laboratory and practical classes in the premises of the University. Detailed rules for conduct of aforementioned classes taking into consideration the current threat to the health of the participants and law in force that regulates rules of operation during the epidemic have to be sent to the Vice-Rector for Educational Affairs until 18th May 2020.

5. A dean/director/head of entity of extra- or inter-faculty at the JU is responsible for realization of tasks described in section 1-3 and organization of classes described in section 4.
6. Organization of clinical classes at the Jagiellonian University Medical College shall be regulated by the ordinance of the Vice-Rector for Medical College.

### § 3

1. Exhibitions of the Jagiellonian University's Collegium Maius and Pharmacy Museum, shall be reopened for visitors and JU Botanic Garden, Jagiellonian Library and Archives shall be open to non-employees of the JU.
2. A detailed rules for functioning of entities mentioned in the section 1 taking into consideration the current threat to the health of the visitors and law in force that regulates rules of operation during the epidemic shall be determined by the director of each entity and have to be sent to the Vice-Rector for Educational Affairs until 18th May 2020.

### § 4

1. The manner of performing work by the employees of university-wide administration entities, administration of faculties and entities of extra- or inter-faculty at the JU, according to the terms of performing work applicable to them while ensuring safe working conditions, taking into consideration the current threat to health of employees and law in force that regulates terms of performing work (including maintaining of sufficient distance between work stations and providing all employees with hand sanitizers regardless of the base of the employment) shall be restored.
2. The JU chancellor/deputy chancellor for Medical College, dean/director/head of entity of extra- or inter-faculty at the JU shall be responsible for realization of tasks described in the section 1.

### § 5

Remaining effective until 25th May 2020 are:

- 1) ordinance no 24 of the Rector of the Jagiellonian University of 10th March 2020 on preventing the spread of COVID-19 in the academic community of the Jagiellonian University;
- 2) ordinance no 28 of the Rector of the Jagiellonian University of 13th March 2020 on special working arrangements at the Jagiellonian University.

### § 6

The ordinance shall enter into force on the date of the signature.
